

At Cleveland, the doctoral degree program is hands-on from the very first trimester. You will participate in a variety of learning opportunities, including lectures, labs, independent and group study projects, research methods and patient care clinical experiences in a clinical internship or off-site multidisciplinary treatment facilities. You may also participate in Cleveland Global Mission trips, where students provide care in remote and underserved regions of the world. It's all part of the program. And key in your development as a chiropractor.

THE FOUR-YEAR CURRICULUM

FIRST YEAR:

Anatomy, embryology, physiology, biochemistry, introduction to chiropractic science and philosophy, hands-on chiropractic functional spinal assessment and adjusting technique.

SECOND YEAR:

Physical exam, neurosciences, radiology, diagnosis, microbiology, pathology, public health, nutrition, intro to research and continued hands-on adjusting technique.

THIRD YEAR:

Pediatrics, geriatrics, dermatology, psychology, extremity adjusting technique, soft tissue procedures, sports chiropractic and internship in the Cleveland Student and Family Clinic.


FOURTH YEAR:
