Federal Pell Grant: Based on the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) determined by the FAFSA. \$6,895 is the maximum per academic year. Not eligible if you have a previous bachelors' degree.

Federal Direct Loans: Must be enrolled in 6 or more credit hours per semester to be eligible. Fixed interest rate is 4.99 %.

Federal Direct PLUS Loans: Student must be enrolled in 6 or more credit hours per semester to be eligible. This is a parent loan taken out on the student's behalf. These are credit-based loans and may borrow up to the cost of attendance. They typically have a lower interest rate than private loans. Fixed interest rate is 7.54 %.

Federal Work Study

This program provides jobs for students with financial need. Most positions are on campus and include teaching assistants, tutors and clerical jobs. Limited funding available.

Private Loans

These are private, credit-based loans and are not eligible to consolidate with federal loans. If approved, students may borrow up to the cost of attendance. More information on our website.
