COURSEWORK

Professional OTA courses at CUKC are listed as "OTHA" courses and must be taken in order and passed with a minimum of a "C" to advance in the degree program. General education courses may be taken in any order or semester prior to taking professional OTA courses. At CUKC, these general education courses are available online, on ground, or as a hybrid.
