Upon successful completion of Cleveland University-Kansas City's Radiologic Technology program, the student will be awarded an Associate of Applied Science degree in Radiologic Technology. The A.A.S. in Radiologic Technology meets the educational requirements for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) primary certification and registration in radiography. Not all states require licensure in order to practice; however, state licenses are usually based on the results of the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT).
